Boys & Girls Club of the Smoky Mountains Nutrition Program

Boys & Girls Club of the Smoky Mountains will provide lunch and snack to any child in the community ages 2-18 at no cost. This will be a Grab-and-Go service at the entrance of each Club site during the hours of 2:00 to 4:00 pm Monday-Friday. The child does not have to be present to receive the food bags. Bags will contain non-perishable food items. Senior Meals

The Sevier County Office on Aging offers mobile meals to homebound seniors over 60 years of age. The cost is on a sliding scale based on the individual's income. Douglas-Cherokee Meals on Wheels

Congregate sites are closed. Home meals - 5 cold meals delivered once a week.

Douglas-Cherokee Meals on Wheels provides hot, home delivered meals to homebound senior's age 60+ Eligibility is primarily for low income and disabled seniors.
