Stay Up to Date with Text and Email Communications . . .



Would you like to receive **TEXT** notifications and announcements about Super Partners activities, events, and travel reminders. Follow the steps below to enroll:

1. The User Group name is **TSBSUPERS**.
2. Send a text message to **8337870873** and enter **TSBSUPERS** in the body of the message.
3. You will quickly receive a reply which states "**TSBSUPERS**" followed by three messages. The first message is to welcome you, the next one to thank you for enrolling, and the last one requesting you to reply to the message with your name.
4. Once you reply with your name, you will receive a final message confirming your membership in the group text.

Protect Yourself from Becoming a Victim of "Vishing" and "Smishing"

Vishing: In vishing attacks, scammers use phone calls or voice messages to impersonate legitimate businesses and trick you into giving them money or revealing personal information. Sometimes these fraudulent calls are made by actual people; other times they are done via robocalls. Worse yet, the scammers may spoof phone numbers that belong to real companies or individuals to deceive you.



Smishing: In smishing attacks, scammers send phishing messages via text messages or messaging apps to your smart phone or tablet. Like phishing e-mails, you are prompted to open a link to access a website or app. The link may take you to a login page to enter your username and password, a form to provide your personal information, or a malicious app that infects your device.

Most fraudsters will make demands for payment, ask for account verification, try to enroll you in a government program, confirm order or shipping information, informing that you won a prize, or pose as technical support employee. Their attempts are for the sole purpose of gaining access to your accounts or electronic devices. Coercion, intimidation, and threats are common tactics to gain control of the decisions you make.

- **Pause, think, and act.** Scammers will stress a sense of urgency through coercion, intimidation, and threats to trick you into doing what they want. Take time to think about what you are being asked to do and why before you take any actions. Don't click on links in text messages.
- **Do not answer the phone or respond to texts from unknown numbers.** If it's a legitimate call, they will leave a message. If the scammers can't reach you, they can't trick you. If you do answer the call, hang up immediately.
- **Keep your personal information private.** NEVER give out personal information such as account numbers, Social Security numbers, passwords, or Multi-factor Authentication (MFA) codes to ANYONE. If you suspect that someone knows your account number, contact the Bank and add a private and secure password to your account.
- **Verify the source.** If you receive a message from someone who says they represent a company or a government agency, hang up and contact them by using the contact information posted on the organization's website.
- **Enable strong security on your accounts.** Creating strong and unique passwords is still a security best practice for protecting your personal and financial information. Change your passwords periodically.
