Day 1: Saturday, December 12, 2026 Boston, Massachusetts Bundle up for a festive journey through charming, historic locales of New England. Get ready to stroll through Boston's old, winding city streets, strewn with sparkling lights and feel the cheer in the chilly New England air. With no scheduled activities today due to varied arrivals, spend the day exploring Boston as you wish.


Day 3: Monday, December 14, 2026 Boston - Bretton Woods, New Hampshire After a relaxed morning, set out for New Hampshire's White Mountains. Arrive at the historic Omni Mount Washington Resort. Step inside The Breakers, the grand mansion built by the Vanderbilt family. After, head to Newport's charming downtown and enjoy free time on your own for lunch and some last-minute holiday shopping at the many boutiques along the waterfront. 
Experience It! Omni Mount Washington Resort
